Dear Student:

Lanier Technical College uses a selection admission process to enroll students for the Practical Nursing Program.

The following criteria must be met for selection to the Practical Nursing Program.

1. Students must have a cumulative average of 2.5 and a minimum of a "C" on the following prerequisite courses: ENG 1010 or 1101; Math 1012 or Math 1101; PSYC 1010 or 1101; ALHS 1011 or BIOL 2113 and BIOL 2113 Lab; BIOL 2114 and BIOL 2114 Lab; ALHS 1060. English 1010 or 1101; Math 1012 or 1101; and ALHS 1011 must be completed one semester prior to entrance of PN Program.
2. Students must have a current CPR/ Health Care Provider certificate card through the American Heart Association before being accepted into the PN program.
3. Students applying for the PN program will be initially admitted into the Healthcare Assistant Certificate program in order to complete the required support and/or core courses for their program of study.
4. Students must submit completed LTC PN Application for selection one semester prior to admission semester, (FALL admission –submit in Spring semester/ Spring admission submit in Summer semester/ Summer admission submit in Fall semester).
5. Students must take the ATI TEAS pre-admission test during or after taking the prerequisite courses. A minimum of 60% composite score is required. There is a \$91.00 fee required to take the test. The test may be taken more than once, but the \$91.00 fee will be charged for each test taken. The test may be taken twice in a calendar year (there must be 30 days between test attempts). TEAS Scores are good for 5 years only.
6. The Practical Nursing admission is a competitive selection process. Meeting the minimum program requirements does not guarantee an applicant's acceptance in the program. This process evaluates the GPA on all prerequisite courses and the ATI TEAS scores. The PN program admits a class every other semester (summer in the odd years;

spring and fall in the even years). Only students that have completed all prerequisites will be considered for selection.

Transfer students must submit a transfer of credit evaluation form to the Registrar's Office and have all transfer of credit issues finalized at least one full semester prior to the semester in which they are seeking admission.

To apply for the ATI TEAS test, go to www.atitesting.com (go to Individuals, Students, Pre-Program, TEAS Entrance Exam Prep) to pay for the test online and create a user account ten days prior to the test date. You must present a photo ID at the testing session in order to be allowed to test. No transfers or refunds allowed. *For more information regarding the ATI TEAS test, contact Joan Ivey at 770-533-6995.*

*If a physical handicap or learning disability prevents you from taking the exam under standard conditions, you may request special testing arrangements by contacting Joan Ivey at least four weeks before the desired test date.

If you're taking the test on or after August 31, 2016, you should purchase the ATI TEAS Sixth Edition study manual.
